

What is PMP certification, and why should I take this class?

What will I learn?

What are the prerequisites?

To apply for the PMP certification exam, you need to have either:

- a secondary degree (high school diploma, associate's degree, or global equivalent) with at least 5 years of the project management experience, with 7500 documentable hours leading and directing projects and 35 hours of project management education, **OR**
- a four year degree (bachelor's degree or global equivalent) and at least 3 years of project management experience, with 4500 documentable hours leading and directing projects and 35 hours of project management education.
